### Dr. Gustavo Scotti di Uccio



*Gustavo Scotti di Uccio joined Selenia SpA in 1975 as **Avionic System Project Leader** and **Avionic Systems Department Head**. In 1980 he was appointed **Avionics Programme Manager** for Tornado, EFA and he Agusta/Selenia Consortium for the EH101 helicopter avionics. In 1989, he was assigned to the European consortium GIE Eurosam (Paris) where he was the **Land Systems Programme Director** within for the Franco/Anglo/Italian missile cooperation FSAF & PAAMS (2 Billion Euro) with also the responsibilities for the industrial cooperation with Germany, UK and Spain.*

*In 1999, in Rome for AMS as **Land System Division Business Development Director**, he followed all major AMS activities within NATO projects and, From 2001, appointed as the **AMS JV NATO Account Director**, Scotti di Uccio was the prime responsible for the liaisons with NATO and NATO Organisations of the AMS Companies in UK, IT, GE, and USA, in connection with BAE Systems and Finmeccanica and in support of industrial cooperation between AMS JV and its industrial partners on NATO projects and to direct the commercial relationships with the NATO Agencies and Organisations. In 2009 in SELEX Sistemi Integrati SpA (Finmeccanica), Gustavo Scotti di Uccio has been appointed **Sn Vice President for New Business Affairs (NATO and EU)** and **Responsible for the US market business opportunities** (liaison with the Finmeccanica DRS company and the*

*US Department for Homeland Security, for crisis and catastrophic events support).*

*He is also been appointed by AIAD (ITA Defence Industry Association) as **National Representative to RTO** (industrial member of the Board), **NIAG** (Ita delegation to), NNEC and NATO-RUSSIA-COUNCIL as **Chairman of a NRC Ad Hoc Working Group** for the industrial cooperation and, from 2008 to 2011 he was **Chairman of the TADIC** (Transatlantic Defence Industrial Cooperation), program with the aim to improve procedures and rules for industrial co-operation for projects taken by NATO.*

*He participated, as expert and chairman, to different WGS and Studies, and recently he contributed as an industrial expert to the definition of the new contractual procedures that are adopted by NATO focussing on cooperations and partnership issues, mainly in the Cyber Domains. In 2007-2009 he was also **Member of the Strategic Steering Committee** of the industrial consortium EURONEC, which provides expertise to the EDA initiative on Network Enabled Capability (NEC), the key tool that will enable information exchange between defence, security and civil actors in CSDP operations. From 2009 to 2001 he was **Member of the National Observatory on Security (OSN)** for critical infrastructures. Since 2004 he is **Member of the Network Centric Operations Industry Consortium (NCOIC)**, an US based, international organization focused on accelerating the global use of network-centric principles and systems.*

*In 1999, appointed as Member of the Board of Directors at ACCSCO SA (Belgian Defence Industry for C2 with shareholders: Thales Raytheon System France, Thales Raytheon Systems US, EADS GMBH Germany, BAE Systems and AMS UK, AMS Italy), and then Company Secretary General. From 2004 in ACCSCO SA, he took the responsibility of **General Manager**.*

*In 2007, appointed as **Member of the Board of Directors at EOS SA** (European Organisation Security). In Eos he **Deputy Chairman** of the Company, Chairman of the Strategic and Membership Committee and member of the Financial Committee. He also animates the Integrated Border Security Working Group, for the analysis and the provision to the European Commission of an industrial (non competitive phase) support in the definition of future requirements.*

*Since dec 2007 he is part of the ESRIF (European Security Research and Innovation Forum) supporting team for the preparation of the "high advice" to the Commission and the EU Institutions on future management and implementation of Security programs.*

*In Sep 2010, after more than 40 years of service, he left the Company, and he is the **Owner of AOS Consultancy Company** (Atlantic Organization for Security – a belgian organization for consultancy and cooperation in the defence and security markets within NATO and EU). The Company supports several industries in the management of their relations with the complex EU and NATO environment, and, together with some advisors, manages some High Level Advice Studies in the fields of defence and security.*

*From 2012 he also contributes to the CESMA (Center of Aeronautical and Space Military Studies) as **Member of the Steering Committee** and responsible for the C4ISR sector and the External Communication.*

*Since 2000 he is also member of the AFCEA (Armed Forces Communications & Electronics Association) for the Washington, Brussels and Rome Chapters and in 2015 he is **Member of the Steering Committee** of the Rome Chapter.*

*Since 2015 he is **Member of the Steering Committee** of the ISSMM-delta (International Security/Safety, Global Strategies and Medical Maxi-Emergency for Unconventional Events: Analyses and Management), a Masters Course organized at the Rome Torvergata University – faculty of Medicine, that aims to give information on the specific skills needed to identify, deal with, and manage Medical Maxi-Emergences related to unconventional Chemical, Biological, Radiologic, and Nuclear (CBRN=A) attacks.*

*Gustavo Scotti di Uccio was born in Salerno, Italy, and received his **University Degree in Physics** with honours (University of Roma); he spent more than 4 years as **Jr Researcher** at the CASACCIA CNEN Center (National Council for Nuclear Research) and at the FRASCATI INFN Laboratories (National Institute for Nuclear Physics) before joining the industrial world, and, as assistant Professor he taught Physics and Nuclear Physics at the Rome University. In 1966 studying Latin and Greek at Classical School he met Grazia and they married in 1976. He has 3 sons, Federico, Nicola, Riccardo, and he lives between Paris (where he reside), Brussels and Rome.*
